

Student Satisfaction Survey Report 2023-24

Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted by IQAC. A sample of 100 students was included in the study out of which 64 students responded. Survey sheds light on various aspects of teaching-learning process at our institution. About 90.6% of respondents expressed contentment with syllabus coverage indicating a comprehensive approach to academic content. On a positive note 85.9% of respondents acknowledged effective communication by teacher. Internal assessment fairness gained positive responses from 89.1% of students, showcasing a perceived equity in evaluation practices. A notable 92.2% of respondents agreed on that the college provide multiple opportunities to learn and grow. Furthermore 89% of students responds that the management makes effort to engage students in the improvement of the teaching learning process. 93.8% of students agreed on the fact that the overall quality of teaching-learning processes in our college is good. About 94% students respond positively to the question that teacher encourage them to perform better. According to 87.5% respondents, teachers have fair rules for class & are extremely impartial. A positive response from 93.8% of students that teachers ask & clear doubts in class. 95% of students (Always + usually) agreed that teachers appreciate hardwork of students towards scoring well in test or performing well in extra curricular activities. Approximately 92% of respondents agreed on the fact that teachers help them to Improve grade after each test.
